This camp will focus on improving EACH player in the areas of shooting, pivoting, passing, agility, defensive awareness and much more. The boys and girls will have exposure to proven methods of instruction while having a great time doing it.

BASIC OUTLINE OF CAMP

The Fast Break Basketball Camp will be held at Cherokee High School in Marlton, New Jersey from Monday, August 1st to Thursday, August 4th 2010. The facility includes three hard wood floor gymnasiums. Camp will begin at 9:00 A.M. and run until 2:00 P.M. Campers should bring a lunch every day. **REPORT TIME FOR CAMP IS 8:45 A.M.**

1. Any player who is an incoming 3rd grader to an incoming 11th grader is welcome. Ages 8 to 17 are appropriate.
2. Players in grades 3rd through 7th will be engaged in an age/ability appropriate instructional environment where the focus is on fundamental player development.
3. Players in grades 8 through 11 will be exposed to Fundamental drills and games, in a highly competitive environment, that prepare or enhance one's ability to be a successful high school player.

4. Players should wear sneakers and have on proper basketball gear.
5. **COST:** The total cost for the week is \$135. This cost includes a t-shirt, special camp awards, insurance, and a basketball for each camper.
